

EARLY DECISION AGREEMENT SPRINGFIELD COLLEGE



The Early Decision Plan is a binding application program for first-year students who have identified Springfield College as their first-choice institution. When you apply through Early Decision 1 or Early Decision 2, and are subsequently offered admission, you agree to enroll at Springfield College. You may apply to other institutions through regular or rolling admission, but can only apply through the Early Decision process at one college or university. Should you receive an aid award that does not make attendance possible, you may decline our offer and be released from the Early Decision Agreement.

Once you are accepted through Early Decision, and receive your financial aid award, you must withdraw the applications that you have submitted at other institutions. If you have questions about whether Early Decision is the right choice for you, please contact our office at (413) 748-3136.

The deadlines for Early Decision are as follows:

Early Decision 1 Application Deadline:	December 1
Early Decision 1 Credential Deadline:	January 1
Early Decision 2 Application Deadline:	January 15
Early Decision 2 Credential Deadline:	February 1

Early Decision 1 candidates will be notified of decisions no later than February 1, and Early Decision 2 candidates will be notified no later than March 1.

A non-refundable enrollment deposit of \$200 is due by March 1 for candidates accepted through Early Decision 1, and by April 1 for candidates accepted through Early Decision 2.
