2008-2009 All College Graduate Scholarship

Description

Each year, a limited number of All-College Graduate Scholarships are awarded. These awards are made on a competitive basis and are designed to fund partial tuition expenses for the 2008-2009 academic year at Springfield College. Recipients must be enrolled in a graduate degree program, and are expected to take at least 9 semester hours during the term(s) in which they utilize the scholarship. Exceptions must be approved by the Graduate Studies Office. The criteria for selection include academic achievement as well as personal accomplishments and professional promise. Financial need is not a factor.

Eligibility

- Applicants must have been admitted to a graduate degree program at Springfield College.
- Applicants entering their first year of graduate study at Springfield College must have an undergraduate cumulative grade point average of at least 3.50 or a graduate cumulative grade point average of at least 3.75, provided they have completed a minimum of 18 semester hours of graduate credit at the time of application.
- Applicants who are presently enrolled as graduate students, but will not have completed 18 semester hours of graduate credit by the end of the Spring Semester, 2008, may apply, provided their undergraduate cumulative grade point average is at least 3.50 and their graduate cumulative grade point average is at least 3.75.
- Applicants who are presently graduate students at Springfield College and who will have completed a minimum of 18 semester hours of graduate credit (including graduate credit taken elsewhere) by the end of the Spring Semester, 2008, may also apply, provided they have a graduate cumulative grade point average of 3.75 or higher.

Application Process

- Applicants must submit the All-College Graduate Scholarship Application and supporting credentials to the Graduate Admissions Office by April 1, 2008.
- A minimum of two All-College Graduate Scholarship Recommendation Forms are required.
- Academic transcripts, currently on file with the Graduate Admissions Office, will be used in the selection process.

Decisions

Decisions will be announced by May 31, 2008 for new graduate students. Returning graduate students will be notified after grades for the Spring Semester have been reported. All applicants will receive written notification of the decision.
